



Nebraska Iowa Electrical Council Code Classes Fall, 2011 • General Information

Times: 9:00 a.m. - Noon and 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. Lunch is on your own.

Notes: All classes will cover changes in the 2011 National Electrical Code, either Part 1 or Part 2, as indicated. You can take any of these classes for 6 hours of credit. It is not necessary to take Part 1 in order to take Part 2. The 2011 NEC went into effect in Nebraska in August and will go into effect in Iowa on January 1, 2012.

Cost: NIEC Member companies' employees - \$60.00 per person per class
Non-member companies' employees - \$70.00 per person per class

Class Locations: On our website, there is a link to a map that shows the exact location of each class location. *In the case of the University of Iowa, there is more detailed information about the class location.*

Continuing Education Credit: Each seminar has been approved by the Nebraska State Electrical Board and the Iowa Electrical Examining Board for six hours of continuing education credit in the code. Certificates will be provided to all attendees the day of the class. In each state, you are required to take a *minimum* of six hours in the NEC, but you *may take all* of your hours in the NEC.

Minimum Enrollment: Each seminar has a minimum enrollment requirement of 25 people. As soon as we reach that number, we will update the website to indicate that the class is a "go".

Confirmation: No confirmation letters will be sent. If the class is full, we will notify you immediately. If you provide an email address, we will send you an email the week of the class as a reminder and to notify you of any changes. If you pay by credit card, you may pick up your credit card receipt when you check in for the class.
